



1859 Petition to Protect Property Including Slaves

Transcript

To the honorable the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Oregon, the undersigned petitioners, residents of the County of Lane and citizens of said Territory would respectfully pray your honorable body to acknowledge by Legislative Act the right of citizens of the United States to emigrate to and settle in the Territory with all their property, (slaves included) and the consequent right to ask and receive protection from the Territorial Government, and in duty bound your petitioners will ever pray.
